Jamestown Basketball Boosters Letter of Understanding for Parents with children on traveling teams

_____ 1. I/we understand that I/we will be responsible to work one concession night (per each child on a traveling team) and to sell 50/50 raffle tickets at that night's game. Also, I/we will be responsible to provide some food items to be sold at the game. If I/we are unable to work, I/we are responsible to find a replacement (other parents, grandparents, etc.) to fill in and work. Failure to do so may result in a monetary fine.

_____ 2. I/we understand that I/we will be responsible to work a full shift (per each child on a traveling team) at the Annual Spring Shoot Out. Shifts will be determined prior to the Spring Shoot Out. I/we also will be responsible to provide some food items to be sold at the tournament. If I/we are unable to work, I/we are responsible to find a replacement (other parents, grandparents, etc.) to fill in and work. Failure to do so may result in a monetary fine.

By fulfilling the above requirements allows the Basketball Booster Board to be able to raise funds to pay for your child's team's gym times for practices. Each team is allowed 2 - 1 ½ hours of practice, at no cost to the team, per week. Last year we paid over \$8,500 combined for all team's practices. Also, we pay your team's tournament fees which combined came to over \$8,000 last year.
